WEXRC is a service offering counselling to women, men and young people (age 12 years and upwards) who have been affected in any way by Domestic, Sexual or Gender-based violence. In addition, we offer support counselling to a partner, family member or friend who is supporting the person who has been abused.

Placement Hours: Sessional

We invite applications from qualified and pre-accredited Adult Counsellors to support clients by:

- Providing short-term focused counselling (max 8 sessions), to clients impacted by Domestic, Sexual and Gender-based violence.

Candidates must possess:

- A recognised qualification in counselling/psychotherapy, minimum Diploma level, recognised by the Irish Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy (IACP) or Irish Association for Humanistic Integrative psychotherapy (IAHIP) or equivalent accrediting body. Pre-accredited with IACP/IAHIP or equivalent body.
- Specific qualification/knowledge of working in a short-term capacity with clients.
- A minimum of 1 year counselling experience.
- Knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel, report-writing and data entry.
